
Evidence: Enterprise-grade security & availability

- Multi-million dollar data centers
- Data encrypted in transit and at rest

Evidence: Gain more control

- Central repository for business-critical information
- Get a clear view of all archived information from the management console
- Provide role-based access to Legal, HR and end users
- Demonstrate chain of custody
- Run advanced reports on archive access, volume of information, etc.





Enterprise Vault.cloud provides rolebased access to archived information.



Evidence: TCO is predictable

- Minimal resources required to install and manage the solution
- Subscription fee includes the following:
 - Data redundancy
 - Maintenance
 - Upgrades
 - Unlimited storage
 - 24/7 customer support
- TCO is often lower than on-premise
- OpEx vs. CapEx on balance sheet



Evidence: Microsoft lacks advanced eDiscovery and compliance capabilities

- Cannot archive the journal
- Provides form-based search
- Does not allow access for multiple discovery reviewers (or outside counsel)
- Offers limited support for content sources

• Will not guarantee where your data will be stored



Evidence: Backup is for recovery, archiving is for discovery

- Backup is highly effective for recovery
- Archived information is indexed and available for real-time searches

 Locally-saved PSTs create additional liability and are difficult to reliably backup
